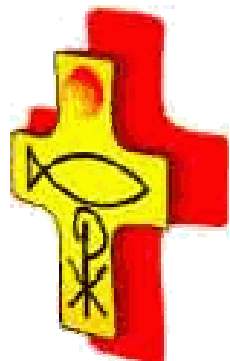

Items may be searched under title, author, subject and includes websites

To place a Reservation:

Select an item—tick the box next to the title

Click 'Hold' at the bottom left, then Click 'Reserve'

Login screen:

Login ID is your **borrower number** from your library card

Password is '**borrower**'

Your reserve list will be displayed.

Check your list, then click 'Reserve'.

If you then **email CRIS** the items can be put aside for you.

Conditions

Loans

Loan periods for audio visual material is 2 weeks, and for print material 4 weeks. Extensions can be arranged by phone, fax or email. Please request before the due date. Overdue fines for music kits are \$1 per day, for videos \$5 per day.

Metropolitan borrowers are responsible for the collection and return of their loan items.

Courier service

Metropolitan borrowers requiring a courier are financially responsible for the collection and return of their loans. All items sent by courier are carefully packed. Please ensure that they are similarly protected for the return journey. The service recommends APD courier service.

For country borrowers the Service pays for postage to borrowers by Australia post. Country borrowers are responsible for return postage.

Damages and losses

Audio visual materials should be shown on well maintained equipment. The borrower in whose name an item is borrowed is responsible for all damages and losses incurred, and may be charged for repair or replacement of items.
